Access:

Unit 207 includes the southern and eastern portion of the Gabbs Valley Range. State Route 361 is the northwestern boundary of Unit 207. It also includes Pilot Mountain in Mineral County. Unit 207 is easily accessible off Highway 95 east of Luning and Mina and from the north off State Route 361. There are several 2-track dirt roads that provide good network of access to the southern portion of the Gabbs Valley Range and Pilot Mountain.

Recommended Hunting Areas: Near the Santé Fe and Table Mountain water developments; Volcano Canyon and associated ridges, canyons, and peaks; New York Canyon, Table and Muller Mountain east of Volcano Canyon; and Water Canyon and Telephone Canyons on Pilot Mountain.

Biologist Comments: Be prepared for a physically demanding hunt. The area is steep and rocky. Four-wheel drive vehicle is recommended if not necessary. Most of the hunting effort will begin from lower elevations off well-maintained roads. Hiking will be the primary means of accessing sheep habitat. Hawthorne has full services including medical, gas, vehicle repair, food, restaurants, and lodging.
