Access: Access to the Silver Peak Range and Volcanic Hills in unit 211 is relatively unrestricted, except by the terrain itself.

Recommended Hunting Areas: If conditions remain warm and dry, sheep may still be tied to water when the November season arrives. Suggested hunt areas in the Silver Peak Range include Icehouse Canyon, Rhyolite Ridge, Nivlock, Emigrant Peak, and Mineral Ridge (excluding the mine). Sheep also occur in the Coyote Hole and Mud Spring areas. In addition, many sheep frequently reside in the Volcanic Hills especially near the two water developments if conditions remain dry until the season. Several wildlife water developments are scattered within the Silver Peak Range from the Rhyolite Ridge area to near Emigrant Peak. These areas can be good even if sheep are not tied to water in the fall.

Biologist Comments: Full services are only available in Tonopah and limited services in Dyer and Goldfield.
