Access: Unit 254 is situated in southern Nye County and comprises the Specter Range. Terrain varies from fairly level, unbroken bajada to steep, rocky canyons and broken ledges. Elevations range from 3,120' to 4,613. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) manages most of the area of occupied bighorn habitat. Hunter access into the Specter Range is only possible from a few roads on the south side of the range. Lands north and east of the Specter Range are within the Nevada National Security Site, and as such, unauthorized entry is prohibited for security and personal safety reasons.

Recommended Hunting Areas: No particular area to focus on.

Biologist Comments: Full services are available in Las Vegas, and some exist in Beatty and Lathrop Wells. Primitive camping is the rule. Sheep hunting in the unit is physically demanding, with portions of the Specter Range being extremely steep and rocky.
