

**Species:** Desert Bighorn Sheep

**Unit Group:** 281

**Access:** Unit 281 comprises the Pintwater Range along the Clark and Lincoln County line. The entire unit is within the boundary of the United States Department of Defense's Nevada Test and Training Range (NTTR South Range) and has no public access. The unit is co-managed with the USFWS Desert National Wildlife Range. Terrain varies from fairly level, rolling hills on the north end to broken ledges and steep rocky canyons in the central and southern portions. Elevations range from 3,400' to over 7,000' at the highest peak on the north end of the unit. There is no scouting allowed before the season opener. Tagholders and their hunting party are only allowed access to the Pintwater Range the day before the season opener through the restricted Point Bravo Gate for the South Range

**Recommended Hunting Areas:** Pintwater Cave, Gravel Springs Canyon, Indian Canyon Dejesus Spring area, and Dain Peak

**Biologist Comments:** Full services are available in Las Vegas, and some services are available in Indian Springs. Primitive camping is the rule.

To apply for hunts on, or gain access to the NTTR South Range, hunters and everyone in their hunting party must comply with all Nevada hunting requirements and then meet the following NTTR requirements:

- 1) Consent to and pass a criminal background check.
- 2) Be 14 years of age or older.
- 3) Attend and comply with the NTTR South Range hunter safety briefing if successful in obtaining a tag.
