Access:

From Winnemucca drive north on Highway 95 and 140. From Orovada, this unit can be accessed off Highway 293. This unit may also be accessed near Denio off highway 140. Primary and secondary road access is relatively good. Four-wheel drive (high clearance) vehicles are recommended to access most of the unit for hunting purposes areas.

Recommended Hunting Areas:

The Montana Mountains, the Double H Mountains, foothill slopes of Kings River Valley, and north and northwest portions of the Bilk Creek Range comprise most of the antelope hunting areas. The top Plateaus on both the Montana Mountains and the Double H Mountains would be areas to concentrate on. Foothills above Kings River Valley is another great place to locate pronghorn. The west side of the Bilk Creek Range offers plenty of area to look at from roughly Bilk Creek Reservoir northward. During hot times of the season, it may be advised to hunt the higher elevations.

Biologist Comments:

No developed campgrounds are available in this unit; however, trailer hookups are available in Orovada and McDermitt. Denio offers limited services as well. Trout fishing opportunities are available but check the fishing regulations to see which waters are open.
