Access:

Access is excellent to all hunting areas with many roads. Private alfalfa farms and native pastures are found in the valleys but do not block access to public lands. Off-road vehicles are recommended when traveling away from the main county roads and a four-wheel drive may be necessary in some areas.

Recommended Hunting Areas:

Antelope are found in all the valleys with higher concentrations in the valleys associated with alfalfa farming throughout this hunt unit group. Areas to look would be: Little Smokey Valley (North) and Jakes Valley in hunt Unit 131; Railroad Valley in hunt Units 131 and 164; Antelope Valley in hunt Units 145 and 163. West Little Fish Lake Valley, Stonecabin Valley and Hot Creek Valleys in Unit 163; Big Sand Springs Valley in Unit 164. Hunters need to be aware of the western unit boundaries for hunt Units 145 and 163. Antelope are usually concentrated around water during both the archery and rifle seasons.

Biologist Comments:

Please be aware that sections of Unit 131 are in wilderness areas. Motorized equipment, mechanized transport, including wheeled game carriers and chainsaws, are prohibited in wilderness areas. Contact the federal management agency responsible for this area for more information.
